A BIT OF HISTORY.....

The "Melbourne Map" from its initial conception in 1986, progressed from a "good idea" into a labour of love as we spent countless thousands of hours over the next 5 years, firstly researching and drawing, then accurately hand colouring the piece. The drawing itself follows the tradition of panoramic city scapes of Melbourne engraved last century by such artists as A.C. Cooke and Samuel Calvert.

Over 7,000 reference photographs were taken, from Hot Air Balloons, from the tops of city buildings and while trekking through all the streets shown. We didn't try to re-create Melbourne building for building; instead we have captured its character and included all the landmarks possible. This was no easy task at a time when Melbourne was experiencing its greatest surge in development. Futuristic drawings and models of proposed developments were sourced and drawn as they would appear when completed.

We do hope the fun we had while researching and creating this view of Melbourne has passed on to the drawing itself, for all Melburnians and her visitors to enjoy.
